3. Absolutely no one may cross the paved road from the parking lot to the arena on horseback. Horses must be led. Failure to do so will result in your ejection from the fairgrounds.
4. No arguing with the parking lot attendents. Some of the shows are very crowded and we must park so that we can accommodate the trailers. The attendants have been doing this job for years. They know what they are doing.
